 - *Regional marketing to increase awareness of adult education; shared resource/bank of CTE teachers, similar to how adjunct professors often teach at multiple colleges, this could be something we help promote since there seems to be a need.*
 - *Structures to ensure that we are all aligned. We have a unique student population and offer unique opportunities. It would be great to be able to speak to the differences of each program to ensure students are provided the program that fits their needs the best.*
 - *I think that the Super Region should continue to support the development of the Program Finder in collaboration with SWP and also support increasing enrollment for all partners by 5%.*
 - *Mapping and alignment of programs across CAEP consortia- deeper partnership with Strong Workforce Consortium - shared marketing campaign*
- Based on the "[Super Region Survey: Direction Looking Forward Fall 2021](#)" survey results some ideas for our Super Region to **Improve the Collaborative Process** included:
 - *Have breakouts, with representatives from each subregion. These could be topic based, or just general catch-up/brainstorming opportunities. I feel like this is difficult when in a large group, but lots of missed chances to collaborate, share, etc. Maybe the first 45 could be everyone and the second 45 could be breakouts?*
 - *Plan one in person event when it is safe to do so. I believe collaboration improves when relationships are built and in person is the best way to do this. Maybe a Spring or end of year event?*
 - *Having more shared resources.*
 - *focus on two or three goals with the understanding that this is a roundtable, not an acting or executing body*
