- Discussion Item I: Strong Workforce Workgroup 1b – *Work facilitated by WestEd*
  - CTE Coding / Alignment Training
    - Approach/Timeline- "Train the Trainer" not moving ahead just yet, WestEd will complete preliminary work and then have the Region validate the work and subsequently decide on next steps. Document with timeline for next few months was shared. Will use SOC Codes but crosswalks will be available to other coding mechanisms.
    - Participants: identified at last meeting
    - Next Steps: Will adhere to timeline, as shared.
  - Data Systems Survey
    - Purpose: Aligning and coding courses, ensuring consistency in nomenclature and being able to aggregate, thus a shared approach.
    - Results to date: 4 agencies have responded and ASAP and TOPSPro are the most frequently used systems

- Super Region Reports/Updates
  - Consortia Updates
    - San Diego- No update
    - North County- ETCN in the process of applying for Perkins funds together, making progress in work groups and putting together a virtual Path to Palomar event
    - East County- Health Occupations Program started up again, making changes to websites and onboarding procedures. Virtual Career and Education Fair in March. New Welding Program being launched in Mountain Empire
    - Mira Costa- Still strategizing with regards to remote testing, introduced Saturday appointments for assessment, classes resuming January 25
    - South Bay- Southwestern College registration is down, making efforts to increase enrollment and engagement via marketing
    - Partner Updates: None
- Discussion Item II: FY 20-21 Focus 1
  - Developing an equity framework across the Super Region
    - Updates: More CalPro equity sessions being offered this year, due date for applications is February 3 and the workshop begins February 5.

- Discussion Item III: FY 20-21 Focus 2
  - Developing a proposal to recommend alternatives to measure student learning gains, rather than relying on standardized testing alone
    - Updates: Doodle poll has been sent out for another meeting. However, consensus is to pause this effort for now due to competing projects. Will check in come April.
- Discussion Item IV: Senate Bill 554 - Exciting project, students have expressed interest in East Region. Could open up further conversations along the same lines in the future.
- Share Out – What's being offered, what's new, who is offering face to face instruction, etc.
  - Palomar will bring limited number of CTE labs back in the Spring but remains mostly online
  - Southwestern also offering very limited face-to-face classes
  - Vista Adult School largely virtual other than medical labs
  - MiraCosta entirely remote
  - Continuing Ed is doing healthcare in person, request for face-to-face culinary classes made
  - Some medical students are eligible for vaccinations, high demand
