- Welcome/Introductions/Additions to Agenda
- Super Region Reports/Updates
 - Consortia Updates
 - North County: Will be posting a Partnership Coordinator (Job Developer) and Technology Integration Specialist soon due to shared position retirements. Adult schools are applying for Perkins funding as a consortium.
 - East County: Working on big remodel at Foothills; planning on re-opening for Summer and Fall for students with social distance guidelines. Looking for an Auto Repair Instructor. Have a donated cement truck on site; looking to utilize as a resource for students.
 - San Diego: Submitted CIP. Exploring a role for a Transition Specialist.
 - South Bay: Transition Coordinator position will be posted for next year. Sweetwater will have a drive-thru and virtual graduation event.
 - MiraCosta: Preparing for commencement (drive-thru event). Preparing for Summer (100% virtual) and Fall; hoping for 2nd term of Fall to have some face to face classes. Working on creating new non-credit certificate programs
 - Partner Updates
 - San Diego Workforce Partnership – The SDWP website for job seekers and staff supporting them now has live staff supporting the chat and the 619-319-9675 work number is available to leave a message after hours and on weekends.
 - County Office of Education - the sector collaboration meetings concluded May 3rd, but will start up again in the fall.
- Discussion Item I: Strong Workforce Workgroup 1b – *Work facilitated by WestEd*
 - CTE Coding/Alignment Project Updates
 - We need to decide who will clean-up spreadsheets from consortia. Homework for next meeting: Identify consortia member/contact person, have them come to next meeting if possible. Need to decide process of how we collaboratively update data when we add new courses and/or pathways?
 - For next year, have data be one of the recurring agenda items in order for Super Region to collaborate on data maintenance.
 - Annual updates may not be enough – we will request updates each semester.
- Discussion Item II: FY 20-21 Focus 1
 - Developing an equity framework across the Super Region
 - Updates: Nothing new at this time.
- Discussion Item III: FY 20-21 Focus 2
 - Developing a proposal to recommend alternatives to measure student learning gains, rather than relying on standardized testing alone
 - *On hold until Coding project is complete*

- Discussion Item IV: Senate Bill 554
 - Update
 - In preparation for their presentation next week, Ute Maschke reached out to consortia and asked for some input regarding their dual enrollment and articulation agreements, so that she and Crystal Robinson would be able to present to the super region with some snapshots from various K-12 adult school programs. During their presentation, we will make clear that these snapshots can only scratch the surface and by no means present in a comprehensive manner what is happening across the region.

 - Next Chair: San Diego – Unknown, elections being held; should be announced by next meeting.
 - Suggestion: Maintain Super Region meetings via Zoom. Perhaps meeting in person once per year, but to save time and travel, Zoom makes more sense.
