- Super Region Reports/Updates
  - Consortia Updates
    - North County: Summit at the end of the month for planning, looking at a case management system but holding off for the moment, submitted Perkins as a consortium, Vista looking for some medical instructors.
    - East County: Most programs are finishing up, North Star digital literacy kicking off for 3 week session, Foothills is undergoing construction.
    - San Diego: San Diego College of Continuing Education – new name and new chancellor too, interim president for a year. Launching first workforce prep bridge program, new culinary hospitality course, annual planning process underway.
    - South Bay: New, modern furniture for next year, Southwestern is rolling out new curriculum with Strong Workforce funds, receiving an award from Goodwill Industries.

- Discussion Item I: Strong Workforce Workgroup 1b – *Work facilitated by WestEd*
  - CTE Coding/Alignment Project – WestEd Presentation
    - Welcome & Introductions
    - Goals and Activities to date – review of progress so far
    - Overview of data repository – Program Finder will be the driver for this work. Repository has been created in Google Sheets for Occupational Training Programs. Can contribute toward program development and alignment as well as gap analyses and planning. Viewing access to be widely available but edit access limited.
    - Next steps- review the sheets for accuracy once given access, come up with a workflow how to maintain this information long-term, i.e. annual updates.
- Discussion Item II: FY 20-21 Focus 1
  - Developing an equity framework across the Super Region
    - Updates: Nothing new at this time.
- Discussion Item III: FY 20-21 Focus 2
  - Developing a proposal to recommend alternatives to measure student learning gains, rather than relying on standardized testing alone
    - *On hold until Coding project is complete*

- Discussion Item IV: Senate Bill 554
  - Updates – nothing new at this time
- Discussion Item V: Super Region Chair FY 2021-22
  - Next Chair: San Diego College of Continuing Education – will determine who will lead soon. Suzanne will forward contact list and information to Kelly.
  - For next year, the meeting time may be moved to 2-4pm instead of 1-3pm.
  - No July meeting this year.
  - In the new fiscal year, in-person meetings may only take place periodically and Zoom meetings will continue.
