- Super Region Reports/Updates
  - Consortia Updates
  - North County - Held 2 virtual Meet the Employer events. Beginning work on virtual Path to Palomar event, overhauled website that is now more employer friendly, held a Data Dialogue with a focus on equity
  - South Bay - continuing with Pathway ESL on 3 different tracks and continuing Adults with Disabilities program
  - East County - Virtual Career and Education Fair was a success, continuing to meet with business partners, moving along with consortium professional learning community on equity
  - Mira Costa - starting embedded counseling for the HSD program, which assigns counselors to faculty members to measure retention, piloting remote El Civics and seeing success so far
  - San Diego - Developing bridge programming to CTE, mentoring program between faculty to assist with distance education, using Student Equity funds for laptop distribution
  - Partner Updates - none

- Discussion Item I: SWP WG1b
  - Strong Workforce Workgroup 1b Update
  - K-12 is moving forward with Strong Workforce Program tool
  - Adult Education does not have a reliable way to pull and aggregate data the way K-12 and Community Colleges can
  - Had meeting with regional Strong Workforce and WestEd members
  - Recommended a 4-phase approach: 1. Document regional CTE course alignments, possible use of CIP or SOC codes; 2. Data Aggregation Systems and Procedures; 3. Clarifying End-User Experience; and 4. Tool Discussion and Development
  - Has great potential but some questions about how to keep it current, what codes to use

Agencies have ten days to voice comments, concerns and thoughts  
Invite WestEd to December meeting

- Discussion Item II: FY 20-21 Focus 1  
Developing an equity framework across the Super Region
  - Updates – CALPRO training will be hosted again in February and March
  - Ongoing concerns about digital equity

**Next Steps:** Participants of current training must complete final assignment by November 20

- Discussion Item III: FY 20-21 Focus 2  
Developing a proposal to recommend alternatives to measure student learning gains, rather than relying on standardized testing alone
  - Updates – Discussion underway to find other learning gain metrics
  - Currently, state still looking at Payment Points for the year...might be a waiver in March but no guarantees
